Qualification Description

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required for individuals to develop skills to meet the needs of supervisors or team leaders in horse breeding or stud farms. It applies to horse breeding operations across disciplines and sectors including for the thoroughbred industry.

No occupational licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

To commence this qualification an individual must have:

- completed or have demonstrated experience in handling horses commensurate with one of the following units of competency:
 - ACMEQU202* Handle horses safely (note ACMEQU205 Apply knowledge of horses is a
 prerequisite to this unit)
 - RGRPSH201 Handle racehorses in stables and at trackwork
 - SISOEQU001 Handle horses.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 12 units of competency:
 - 2 core units plus
 - 10 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

- at least 4 elective units from Group A
- up to 6 electives from Group A, B or C not already selected
- up to 2 from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
