Their knowledge base may be highly specialised or broad within the agribusiness field. These individuals are often accountable for group outcomes and for the overall performance of an agricultural or horticultural production enterprise, that they would like to further develop in order to create further educational or employment opportunities.

Job roles and titles vary across different industry sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:

- Rural and regional agribusiness manager (including lending managers, insurance brokers, machinery dealers, chemical resellers, stock agents, grain marketers, real estate agents)
- Agriculture enterprise business manager
- Production horticulture enterprise business manager
