IRC Skills Forecast and Proposed Schedule of Work 2019-2022

The IRC approved the draft of the *Animal Care and Management IRC Skills Forecast and Proposed Schedule of Work 2019-2022* (Skills Forecast), subject to further public and IRC member feedback. The IRC requested further work be undertaken concerning potential equine training projects, including seeking feedback from the Racing and Breeding and Sport and Recreation IRCs.

Project Update

Skills Impact presented a progress report on the <u>Animal Incident Management Project</u>, <u>Animal Technology Project</u> and <u>Horse Education Project</u>. Currently projects are at the *Drafts Available* stage and there is a good level of feedback for all projects. The projects are tracking well against the timeline, for finalization due in April 2019 and submission due at the end of June 2019.
