20-03 Biosecurity and Emergency Response



Summary of Feedback, Responses and Actions

April 2020

This project includes the development of four new skill sets and the review of 13 units of competency within the AHC Agriculture, Horticulture and Conservation and Land Management Training Package. Draft materials were developed as a result of initial input from Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) and were made available for broader stakeholder consultation and feedback between 7 November – 9 December 2019. During this time feedback was received via email, through online surveys, as well as in person at workshops or site visits, and by telephone. Input was received from 36 stakeholders around Australia, including 14 industry employers/employees, four industry associations, three Registered Training Organisations, 15 from Government bodies such as Department of primary industry, Department of agriculture, Departments and State Training Authorities, with the rest comprising of industry advisory organisations.

Validation drafts were also made available online from 13 February – 1 March 2020, and validation meetings were held on 26th and 27th of February in Sydney and Adelaide respectively with SMEs, with representatives from:

As a direct result of feedback received, minor changes were made to the documents under review. Most notably:

- Standardisation of wording
- Minor changes to Knowledge Evidence
- Minor changes to or removal of duplication in Performance Criteria
- Increase of requirement for performance evidence
- Confirmation or minor changes to component titles

Note: the Australian Workers Union was contacted during the initial phases of the project so they could have the opportunity to participate, but no feedback was received. Stakeholders from Tasmania and the Australian Capital Territory were asked for feedback during the validation phase of this project. Tasmanian stakeholders informed Skills Impact that the feedback they offered during the Public Consultation phase of the project was sufficient and no response was received from stakeholders within the ACT.

Below is a summary of the issues raised for the draft units of competency and skill sets developed and reviewed for the 20-03 Biosecurity and Emergency Response project, and how these issues have been dealt with. This involves a consideration of the information provided, views of industry stakeholders and from people who are part of the Subject Matter Expert Working Group process. Resolutions are constructed to consider the needs and views of stakeholders to the extent possible, and to comply with the Standards for Training Package 2012. The resolutions may represent a compromise on one or more stakeholder views with the aim of a workable outcome for industry, State and Territory Training Authorities (STAs) and training providers.
