## Dairy and Milk Product Project

Summary of Validation Feedback, Responses and Actions

## Skills Impact

#### 21 June 2021

This project includes the development of one new skill set and the review of one qualification and six units of competency within the AHC Agriculture, Horticulture and Conservation and Land Management Training Package. The final draft materials were developed as a result of feedback provided by stakeholders and Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) during the validation period between 30 April to 14 of May 2021.

Two validation meetings were held on 3 May and 4 May 2021, where all documents were validated. Validation feedback was also received from a variety of stakeholders around the country via phone, email, virtual meetings and the Skills Impact feedback hub. The table below provides an overview of the groups and jurisdictions that have provided feedback during this phase of the project.
