Qualification Description

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required to work safely in a range of skilled roles in the industries involving horses, including stable hand, stud hand, groom; farm hand and rider. Workplaces may include agistment centres, riding schools, horse yards, competition stables, polo stables, breeding studs, riding centres, equine veterinary facilities and horse education facilities.

Individuals in these roles perform a range of horse care tasks under broad direction which involve discretion and judgement in handling, housing, feeding, and exercising horses. They take responsibility for their own work, carry out assigned tasks, organise processes, work to schedules, solve problems and comply with animal welfare requirement. They may also perform ridden and non-ridden horse exercise and prepare horses for events.

This qualification is suitable to be undertaken as an apprenticeship or traineeship pathway.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 16 18 20 units of competency:
 - 89 -10 core units plus
 - 89 10 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

- 4 5 from Group A
- up to 4 5 from remaining electives in Groups A, B or C
- up to 3 4 from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.

At least 5 of the 10 electives selected must be coded at indicative AQF level 3 or above or reflect AQF level 3 outcomes or above.
