Qualification Description

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required for individuals licensed to operate as a jockey and compete in industry-regulated events in the thoroughbred racing code.

Jockeys are athletes who ride racehorses at race meetings, barrier trials and trackwork. A jockey possesses the highest level of race riding skills, requiring a high degree of decision-making skill and reaction time during races, and the ability to exercise judgement when choosing mounts and assessing horse form.

This qualification is required for industry licensing and registration in some states and territories. Refer to the relevant state or territory Principal Racing Authority for current requirements.

Entry Requirements

To commence this qualification an individual must demonstrate they have skills and knowledge in the application of:

- riding and handling of thoroughbred horses including riding trackwork at a high skill level
- health and safety processes and regulations that apply in a thoroughbred racing environment
- · personal health and fitness as it applies to working with thoroughbred horses
- safely maintaining a healthy weight to participate in the sport as required by the Australian Rules of Racing

The skills and knowledge may have been acquired through completion of a Certificate III in Racing (Trackwork) or relevant experience.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 17 units of competency:
 - 9 core units plus
 - 8 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

- at least 6 from the electives listed below
- up to 2 from any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
