- · Farm production manager
- Production unit manager
- · Station/property manager.

Individuals with this qualification will take personal responsibility and exercise autonomy in undertaking complex work. They must analyse information and exercise judgement to complete a range of advanced skilled activities.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

Entry Requirements

To commence this qualification, individuals must demonstrate they have skills and knowledge in the application of:

- · livestock production skills, or
- · agriculture crop production skills, or
- · mixed farming cropping and livestock production skills

The skills and knowledge may have been acquired through completion of a Certificate III or higher qualification relating to agriculture, or two years relevant agriculture industry experience.

Packaging Rules

To achieve this qualification, competency must be demonstrated in:

- 10 units of competency:
 - 4 core units plus
 - 6 elective units.

Elective units must ensure the integrity of the qualification's Australian Qualification Framework (AQF) alignment and contribute to a valid, industry-supported vocational outcome. The electives are to be chosen as follows:

- 2 units must be from group A
- 2 units must be from groups A or B
- 2 units must be from the remaining units listed in groups A or B, or any currently endorsed Training Package or accredited course.
