Racing Project Summary of Feedback, IRC Responses and Actions



Qualifications, skill sets and units of competency from the *RGR08 Racing Training Package* were reviewed and redeveloped for inclusion in the *RGR Racing Training Package*. Appropriate national and state/territory level consultation took place with the racing industry, including Principal Racing Authorities, jockey associations, subject matter experts and training providers.

During the 'Development' stage of the project, information-gathering sessions were held with Principal Racing Authorities and subject matter experts to determine the current skill needs of racing industry job roles.

The table below provides a summary of the changes made to draft components as a result of the information gathering sessions.

Overview of feedback received during consultation stage

The draft components were available for broad industry consultation and feedback from 19 October to 10 November 2017. During this time, feedback was collected via the Skills Impact website, via comments and survey completions, webinars and stakeholder meetings.

The following table is a summary of feedback received and the actions taken to produce the final drafts. The Industry Reference Committee (IRC) considered all feedback and recommended actions, taking into consideration the requirements of the *Standards for Training Packages* 2012. The recommended actions aim to provide a workable outcome for industry, State Training Authorities and training providers.
