2018-2019 AHC Case for Endorsement provisional sign-off

The APH IRC considered the 2018-19 Agriculture, Horticulture and Conservation and Land Management (AHC) Case for Endorsement.

APH IRC members reviewed the four projects undertaken by Skills Impact on behalf of the APH IRC that related specifically to the Agriculture and Production Horticulture section.

The meeting approved provisional sign off of the AHC Case for Endorsement and authorisation to the APH IRC chair to approve the final version on behalf of the APH IRC.

Grain Traders Course Re-accreditation
